ABOUT OUR MULCHES

Our mulches are designed for both the home gardener and landscaper in mind. Adding mulch to your garden is highly beneficial.

By mulching your garden you will.

- Reduce soil erosion
- Retain soil moisture during warm seasons
- Insulate plant roots during cold seasons
- Add nutrient to the soil
- Reduce weeds
- Improve overall health of soil
- Improve visual appeal of your garden

Weed mat is not required when using mulch

Lay mulch with a minimum depth of 5cm. Mulch will need to be topped up at some stage due to wear and tear that is caused by weather elements, decomposition, birds and other animals moving it.

Our mulch is sold by the cubic metre and by the bag.

Working out the amount of mulch you need ensures that you have the correct amount rather than too much or not enough by guessing your measurements. If you supply our staff with the measurements of the length and width of your garden in metres and centimetres, we will be able to work out how many cubic metres that you require.

Mulch is a finely mulched Pine bark. It is also known as Hammermill Mulch

Graded Bark is a Pine Bark that is larger in size than the Mulch approximately 10-15mm in size. It is the heaviest bark we stock

Dyed Red Mulch is a recycled hardwood that has been dyed red during processing.

- Holds its colour

Dyed Black Mulch is a recycled hardwood that has been dyed black during processing.

- Not recommended for vegetable gardens
- Not ideal for playgrounds
- Holds its colour

Soft Fall Mulch is a Pine and Hardwood Woodchip

- Suitable for most garden situations
- Ideal for modern gardens
- Not ideal for vegetable gardens
- Certified for use in playgrounds
- Colour may fade

Soil Conditioner Mulch is finely shredded 100% green waste, collected from local councils. It has been sorted shredded and pasteurised (heated to kill bacteria).

- Ideal for cottage gardens
- Not ideal for vegetable gardens
- Not ideal for playgrounds
- Colour may fade

Mushroom Compost is a blend of wheaten straw, chicken manure, and gypsum composted and pasteurized (heated to kill bacteria) prior to growing a mushroom crop. Once mushrooms are harvested it is then used in gardens as a compost or mulch. It contains almost all nutrients needed for good plant growth, improves soil structure, and conserves soil moisture.

- Ideal as a mulch for established gardens, especially roses
- Ideal for rejuvenating established gardens
- Ideal for rejuvenating Vegetable gardens after harvesting
- Not recommended for new gardens
- Not recommended for use near Palms, Ferns, Lawns or Natives

Sugar Cane Mulch is mulched up, dried sugar cane leaves

- Great for vegetable gardens
- Can be used on any garden new or established
- Adds nitrogen to the soil
- Great soil improver for vegetable gardens
- Great for no dig gardens

Pea Straw is mulched up, dried pea vines.

- Great for vegetable gardens
- Can be used on any garden new or established
- Adds nitrogen to the soil
- Great soil improver for vegetable gardens
- Great for no dig gardens
